Mayor Hudson opened the meeting at 4:00 p.m. Advance notice and a copy of the agenda were given to the Council and members of the press. City Council meetings are conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Act, a copy of which is available for public inspection on the north wall of the Council Chambers.

On August 19th the Council approved GRN 2nd Subdivision which replatted Goshen Subdivision from eight 70 foot lots into seven 80 foot lots making them more hospitable to the planned home construction by the CROWN Housing developer.

The Register of Deeds had issues filing the plat because of the plat title; there is no GRN Subdivision, the original plat was named Goshen Subdivision. To rectify the situation the GRN Second Subdivision, an addition replatting Lots 2 – 4, inclusive and 13-17, inclusive, and the vacated alley lying between Lot 4 and 13, GRN Subdivision, City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, needs to be vacated. Once that is done, the Pony Express Foundation will submit an Administrative Plat application that will accomplish the realignment of the lots.

Discussion was had and a motion made by Kennedy, seconded by Whiting, to vacate GRN Second Subdivision. Roll call vote: Yea – Kennedy, Strauser, Whiting. Nay – none. Absent and not voting – Aden.

Kennedy moved, Strauser seconded, to adjourn the meeting at 4:30 p.m. Roll call vote: Yea – Strauser, Whiting, Kennedy. Nay – none. Absent and not voting – Aden.
