- Shane Gruber is talking with Paulsen's about the paving on Avenue F from the water leak under mining. The street employees will try to get it out and have Paulsen's put it in.

The NMPP Cost of Service Study is a 2 year agreement that costs \$11,170.00. This is the normal rotation to enter into agreement, but the NPPD rates have been stable so Administrator Clymer thought about skipping this year and address it again next year. No action was taken at this time; Council will address it next year.

Project 2020 will be discussed at the end of the meeting.

Jacque Haupt with Miller and Associates stated there were 3 bids opened for the Westside Water/Sewer Improvements; they were from Van Kirk Bros Contracting, Midlands Contracting, and Myers Construction. They were over the original funding amount from the EDA. This should be awarded contingent upon EDA & SRF, but they need to know how to handle the shortfall.
