

ORDINANCE # 12

An ordinance to prohibit and suppress the maintenance or operation of pool, snooker, or billiard halls, or bowling alleys, within the corporate limit of the city of Gothenburg, Nebraska; and to prohibit and suppress the use of, playing upon, or permitting to be played upon, of pool, snooker, or billiard tables, or ten-pin or bowling alleys, within the corporate limits of the city of Gothenburg, Nebraska, except in private residences; and to provide a penalty for the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance; and to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith: and to provide for the time that this ordinance shall take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, corporation, or association of persons, to maintain or operate a pool, snooker, or billiard hall, or bowling alley, within the corporate limits of the city of Gothenburg, Nebraska.

Section 2. That it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, corporation, or association of persons, to use, play upon, or permit to be played upon, any pool, snooker, or billiard table, or bowling or ten-pin alley, within the corporate limits of the city of Gothenburg, Nebraska, except in private residences of said city.

Section 3. That each day that any such pool, snooker, or billiard hall, or bowling alley, is maintained or operated, or that any such pool, snooker, or billiard table, or bowling or ten-pin alley, is used, played upon, or permitted to be played upon, except in private residences, shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

Section 4. That any person, firm, partnership, corporation, or association of persons, who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be

fined for each offense not less than Twenty-Five Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars, and upon conviction thereof, shall stand committed to the city or county jail until such fine together with the costs of prosecution are fully paid.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.
