

ORDINANCE # 78

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA, to amend Section Number 26 of Ordinance No. 1 of said City, relating to Time of Sounding Curfew, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section Number 26 of Ordinance Number 1 be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. It is hereby made unlawful for any person under 16 years of age to be or to remain in or upon the streets, alleys, or public places in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, at night, after the hour of TEN o'clock P.M., unless such person is accompanied by parent, guardian, or other person having the legal custody of such minor person, or is in the performance of an errand of duty directed by parents, guardian, or other person having the legal custody of such minor person, or whose employment makes it necessary to be upon the streets, alleys, or public places, during the night time after such specified hours.

Section 3. That the Chief of Police of said City shall cause the city siren to sound the curfew warning hereafter at the said hour of TEN P. M.

Section 4. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this amendment to said ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.
