

ORDINANCE # 95

An Ordinance of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, to Amend Section 40 of Chapter 4 of Ordinance Number 1 on the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, for the year 1947 Relating to the Parking of Motor Vehicles along the Streets of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 40 of Chapter 4 of Ordinance Number 1 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska for the year 1947, be amended to read as follows:

Section 40. PARKING -- HEREAFTER, it shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to park or allow the same to remain stationary along any street in the business district of this City, unless said motor vehicle shall be parked not more than on (1) tier deep on either side of said streets, and headed into the curbs on the sides of said streets at an angle of approximately forty-five (45) degrees, the driver having turned to the right to enter said parking place. On all other streets in said City, all motor vehicles shall be parked next to the curb, or side of the street, and parallel to said curb or side of the street, the driver having turned to the right to enter said parking place. Under no circumstances shall any motor vehicle be parked in any alley in this City. PROVIDED, that it shall be unlawful to park closer to any fire hydrant or fire house entrance in this City than twenty (20) feet, or in any other space set off and marked "No-Parking," when done by order of the City Council. PROVIDED FURTHER, that it shall be unlawful to park for a greater length of time than marked in any space set off and marked with the number of minutes of allowable parking, when such marking is done by order of the City Council. PROVIDED FURTHER, parking in the center of the street will be allowed where so set off and marked, when such marking is done by order of the City Council.

Section 2. That Section 40 of Chapter 4 of Ordinance Number 1 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, for the year 1947 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
