

ORDINANCE # 105

An ordinance of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, prohibiting the operation, use, or public display in on-sale beer taverns within the corporate limits of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, of pin-ball machines, shuffle boards and all the other devises of a similar nature, providing penalties for the violation hereof, and repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith:

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, firm or corporation to operate, display or provide for the use of the public any pin-ball machines, shuffle boards or similar devises in licensed on-sale beer taverns within the corporate limits of the City of Gothenburg.

SECTION II. Any person, partnership, firm or corporation violatting any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 for each offense. Each distinct act or violation of the terms of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense. Each day or any part thereof in which this ordinance shall be violated shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION III. That an emergency exists and that this ordinance shall be operative immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.

SECTION IV. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V. This ordinance shall take affect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
