

ORDINANCE NO. 114

An Ordinance to Vacate that portion of Jefferson Street between Avenue H and 12th Street of Gothenburg, Nebraska; and to Repeal All Ordinances or Parts of Ordinances in Conflict Herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG,
NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Whereas the west end of Jefferson Street connects with 12th Street at an acute angle, and said street, together with Ave. H, bound Block Thirty-four (34), First Addition of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, in such a way that said Block Thirty-four (34) is a small triangular block. That Jefferson Street between 12th Street and Avenue H has never been used and to open said street would not be economically feasible, and portion of Jefferson Street should be vacated.

Section 2. That portion of Jefferson Street between the south line of 12th Street and the west line of Avenue H, in Gothenburg, Nebraska, is hereby vacated and the land so vacated shall revert to the owners of lands and lots abutting thereto so that each abutting landowner shall own said land to the center of the street so vacated.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
