

ORDINANCE # 122

An Ordinance To Vacate Ten Feet (10') on the North Side of 20th Street Between Avenue A and Avenue M, and Ten Feet (10') on the South side of 20th Street, From Avenue A to Avenue M, and to Repeal All Ordinances in Conflict Herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Whereas, on the 20th day of October, 1921, the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska attempted to narrow 20th Street from one hundred feet to eighty feet by passing a resolution vacating a strip ten feet wide on each side of said 20th street from Avenue A to Avenue M, and whereas, such resolution was ineffectve, and whereas, it would be more economical to maintain said street if it were reduced from one hundred feet in width to eighty feet in width.

SECTION 2. A strip of land ten feet wide on the North side of 20th street and a strip of land ten feet wide on the South side of 20th Street, all between Avenue A and Avenue M is hereby vacated.

SECTION 3. The land so vacated in Section 2 hereof shall revert to the owners of lands or lots abutting thereto.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
