

ORDINANCE NO. 124

An Ordinance Appropriating Money to Defray the Necessary Expense and Liabilities of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, for the Fiscal Year, Beginning on the First Tuesday of May, 1955 and Ending on the First Tuesday of May, 1956.

Be it ordained by the mayor and council of the city of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of all the funds of the city of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, the sum of \$64,800.00 this sum being necessary to defray the expenses and liabilities of said city for the said fiscal year beginning the First Tuesday of May, 1955 and ending on the First Tuesday of May, 1956.

Section 2. That the unexpended balances in all funds at the close of the fiscal year Ending the First Tuesday of May, 1955, be and are hereby reappropriated to their respective funds for the coming year.

Section 3. That the following amounts be and are hereby appropriated from the general fund and the other respective funds for the following purposes:
