

ORDINANCE # 125

An Ordinance of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska providing for the Abandonment of the South Fifteen (S 15') Feet of Lot Three (3), Block One (1), of Church Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, and providing for the sale thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. On the 10th day of February, 1934, the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska acquired by purchase the following described real estate for the purpose of using the same for an alley, to-wit:

The South Sixteen (S 16') Feet of Lot Three (3), in Block One (1), of Church Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 2. A portion of said real estate, together with other land, was used and is still being used for the purpose of an alley. The land described as follows, to-wit:

The South Fifteen (15) Feet of Lot Three (3), in Block One (1), Church Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska,

is no longer used for any purpose and the same is and is hereby declared abandoned and sale of the same is deemed expedient.

Section 3. Sale of said real estate shall be held by submission of sealed bids, the same to be submitted to the Mayor and Council at the City Hall in Gothenburg, Nebraska on or before 8:00 o'clock P. M. on Tuesday, ~~November 15th~~ ^{November 15th}, 1955, and shall be opened between the hours of 8:00 o'clock P.M. and 9:00 o'clock P.M. on said date.

Section 4. The sale shall be made to the highest bidder, upon receipt of 15% of the bid price at the time the bid is accepted and balance of purchase price within ten (10) days thereafter, PROVIDED, the Mayor and City Council reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 5. Notice of the sale of said real estate shall be given by publishing the same in the Gothenburg Times at least thirty days prior to said sale.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
