

ORDINANCE No. 156

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE PLAT OF BLOCKS SEVEN (7) and EIGHT (8) of LAKE VIEW ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND THE ALLEYS EXTENDING EAST AND WEST THROUGH SAID BLOCKS, AND TWENTY-FIFTH STREET FROM AVENUE F. TO AVENUE G. IN SAID CITY AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES THAT CONFLICT HERewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. WHEREAS, Ernest Johnson and Abbie A. Johnson, husband and wife, are the owners of Block Seven (7) and Estella Geiken, a widow, is the owner of Block Eight (8) all in Lakeview Addition to Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, and have filed their petition asking that the Plat of said Blocks, the alleys extending East and West through said blocks and Twenty-fifth Street from Avenue F to Avenue G in said City, be vacated, and it appearing that the lots and alleys in said blocks have never been laid out nor have the alleys extending through said block ever been opened, nor has Twenty-fifth Street extending from Avenue F to Avenue G ever been opened; the alleys through Blocks Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14) of Lakeview Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, having been vacated and said alleys changed to extend North and South, we deem it advantageous and best for the interests of the City to vacate said lots, alleys and said street as herein described.

Section 2. NOW THEREFORE, the lots and alleys extending East and West through Block Seven (7) and Eight (8) Lakeview Addition to Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, and Twenty-fifth Street from Avenue F to Avenue G within said city, are hereby wholly and entirely vacated and shall no longer be or constitute the description as set forth in the plat of said addition now on file and the alleys extending East and West through said Blocks and Twenty-fifth Street from Avenue F to Avenue G between said Blocks shall revert to the owners of the lots or lands abutting

the same in proportion to the respective ownership of such lots or grounds.

Section 3. ALL ORDINANCES and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force from and after its passage and approval and publication as required by law.
