

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA, PROVIDING THAT THE SEWAGE SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA BE SUPERVISED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF SAID CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That the supervision of the sewage system of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska shall henceforth be under the direction of the Board of Public Works of the said City, which said Board of Public Works was created by Ordinance Number 132.

SECTION 2. The Board of Public Works shall have the active direction and supervision of the sewage system to be used and operated by said City of Gothenburg, Nebraska. Said Board of Public Works shall have the power to operate said sewage system and to exercise all powers conferred by the law upon the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, for the operation and government of said sewage system to the same extent, in the same manner, and under the same restrictions as the City Council could do if no such Board of Public Works existed, except, HOWEVER, that said Board of Public Works shall not make any expenditure or contract any indebtedness other than for ordinary running expenses, exceeding in amount \$1,000.00, without first obtaining the approval of the City Council.

SECTION 3. That the provisions of Ordinance Number 132 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, providing for the creation of the Board of Public Works, shall be applicable insofar as the operation and control of said sewage system is concerned, to the same extent as related to the direction and supervision of the electric distribution system and the water works owned by the said City of Gothenburg, Nebraska.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

SECTION 6. That a state of emergency exists by reason of the imminent

acquisition by the City of additional sewage lines to be constructed within said City, and shall take effect on the proclamation of the Mayor, posted in at least three of the most public places in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska.
