

ORDINANCE NO. 179

An ordinance providing for the sale of the North Eighty Feet of the East One Hundred Thirty-four Feet of Block Twenty-nine, Lakeview Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, together with a strip of vacated street, Ten Feet in width, on the North side thereof and contiguous thereto; providing for the conveyance of said real estate and the manner and terms thereof; providing for notice of said sale and providing for the repeal of all prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG,

NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That the real estate described as the North Eighty Feet of the East One Hundred Thirty-four Feet of Block Twenty-nine, Lakeview addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, together with a strip of vacated street, Ten Feet in width, on the North side thereof and contiguous thereto, is not and never was used in the operation of public utilities, nor was the same acquired through tax foreclosure proceedings.

SECTION 2. That said real estate shall be sold and conveyed for the purpose of correcting title to the present occupants and record title holders, for the sum of One Dollar, cash, and all interest of said city in said real estate shall be so conveyed by quit claim deed, and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute said deed on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. That notice of said sale shall be published in the manner and within the time as provided by law, which notice shall provide that should a remonstrance against such sale, signed by legal electors of said City of Gothenburg equal in number to thirty per cent of the electors of such city, voting at the last regular municipal election held therein, be filed within thirty days after the passage and publication of this ordinance, said property shall not then nor within one year thereafter be sold, unless such sale be ratified by a majority of the electors of such municipality voting upon the same at a special or general municipal election at which the same is submitted.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
