

ORDINANCE NO. 186

Ordinance amending Section 3-5-24 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code of 1961, allowing for the prohibition of the parking of trucks within designated areas by resolution; providing for the repeal of all prior ordinances in conflict herewith; providing the time when this ordinance shall be in full force and effect and providing for the penalty for the violation hereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG,

NEBRASKA:

Section 1.

That Section 3-5-24 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code of 1961 be amended to read as follows:

The City Council may, by resolution, entirely prohibit or fix a time limit for the parking and stopping of vehicles in any street or streets or district designated by such resolution, and entirely prohibit or fix a time limit for the parking and stopping of trucks or trailers as hereinafter defined and the parking and stopping of any vehicle in any such street, streets or district for a period of time longer than fixed in said resolution, or the stopping of trucks and trailers where prohibited, or for a period of time longer than fixed in such resolutions shall constitute a violation of this ordinance.

In addition, each period of time that any vehicle shall remain in any parking space beyond the period of time prescribed for such parking space shall constitute a separate and distinct offense, and each time a truck or trailer shall stop or be parked in an area where prohibited by said Resolution shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. During any one day it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be consecutively parked on the same side of the same street in any block for a longer period of time than so designated for such street.

Section 2.

The term "truck" within the meaning of this ordinance shall mean any vehicle, the primary purpose of which is for the hauling of articles other than passengers, larger than is what is commonly referred to as

a "pickup truck." The term "trailer" shall include any vehicle towed by another vehicle, and used for the purpose of hauling any type of material, or to be used for the housing of individuals, and generally referred to as camping trailers or house trailers.

Section 3.

Any person upon whom a duty is placed by the provisions of this ordinance who shall fail, and neglect or refuse to perform such duty or who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be punishable under the provisions of Section 3-5-86 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code of 1961.

Section 4.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances, passed and approved prior to the passing and approval of this ordinance and in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 5.

This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
