

ORDINANCE NO. 201

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE WILLFUL INTERFERENCE WITH OBSTRUCTION, DISTRACTION, OR HINDERANCE OF ANY POLICE OFFICER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES; PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1: Any person who shall willfully interfere with, obstruct, distract, or hinder any police officer in the performance of his duties shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution for every such offense, and may, by order of the court, be adjudged to stand committed to the City Jail until such fine and costs be paid, secured, or otherwise discharged according to law.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT. All ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this Ordinance and in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar and only to the extent that they are in conflict herewith.

SECTION 3. WHEN OPERATIVE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
