

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE VEHICLES TO STOP AT INTERSECTIONS WHERE A FLASHING RED LIGHT TRAFFIC SIGNAL IS OPERATIONAL, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT: AND PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle through an intersection at which a traffic signal consisting of flashing red light has been erected when said signal is operational, from any direction in which said red flashing red light is visible, without first bringing said vehicle to a complete stop before entering the intersection.

Section 2. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$100.00 and shall stand committed to the city jail until such fine and costs of prosecution are paid.

Repeal of Prior Ordinance in Conflict. All Ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

When Operative. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
