

ORDINANCE NO. 215

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA TO COOPERATE WITH AND AID IN THE PLANNING, CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF LOW RENT HOUSING PROJECTS DESIGNED FOR OCCUPANCY BY THE ELDERLY AND FAMILIES OF LOW INCOME, AND TO CALL A REFERENDUM ELECTION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA, SHALL BE AUTHORIZED AND PERMITTED TO COOPERATE IN SAID PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. The Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, hereby find and determine that it is for the best interests of the City to cooperate with and aid in the planning construction and operation of low rent housing projects designed for occupancy by the elderly and families of low income.

Section 2. That a special referendum election is hereby called and shall be held on April 1, 1969, in which election the following proposal shall be submitted to the electors of said city, to-wit:

"Shall the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, be authorized and permitted to cooperate with and aid in the planning, constructing and operation of low rent housing projects designed for occupancy by the elderly and families of low income?"

Those in favor [redacted] shall place an "X" in the square preceding the words "For the proposal" and those opposed to said proposal shall place an "X" in the square preceding the words "Against the proposal."

The polls will be open from Eight A.M. until Eight P.M. on said day and electors shall vote in the Ward and election district in which they respectively reside. The polling places for such election shall be as follows:

All voters of said City residing in the First Ward of the City of Gothenburg shall vote at the City Hall, Gothenburg, Nebraska.

All voters of said City residing in the Second Ward of the City of Gothenburg, shall vote at the Community Building, Gothenburg, Nebraska.


All voters of said City residing in the Second Ward

Section 3. Notice of the calling of the special election shall be given by publication in the Gothenberg Times Gothenburg, Nebraska, a legal newspaper printed and of general circulation in the City of Gothenburg, three successive weeks prior to the election.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall cause ballots to be printed and shall furnish the same to the election boards which ballots shall set out the proposal at length followed by the words "For the proposal", preceded by a square, and the words "Against the proposal", preceded by a square, "The electors voting in favor of the proposal shall mark an "X" in the square preceded by the words "For the proposal", and those voting against said proposal shall mark an "X" in the square preceding the words "Against the proposal."

Section 3. Notice of the calling of the special election shall be given by publication in the Gothenburg Times, Gothenburg, Nebraska, a legal newspaper printed and of general circulation in the City of Gothenburg, three successive weeks prior to the election.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall cause ballots to be printed and shall furnish the same to the election boards which ballots shall set out the proposal at length followed by the words "For the proposal", preceded by a square, and the words "Against the proposal", preceded by a square. The electors voting in favor of the proposal shall mark an "X" in the square preceded by the words "For the proposal", and those voting against said proposal shall mark an "X" in the square preceding the words "Against the proposal."
