

ORDINANCE NO. 222

An ordinance authorizing the purchase of a road maintainer; to declare an emergency, and to provide when this ordinance takes effect.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska:

Section 1.

That a motor grader belonging to the City has become in a state of disrepair, and that it is necessary that another such motor grader be obtained by the City immediately in order to properly maintain the streets and alleys of said City.

Section 2.

That the Mayor, or in his absence, the President of the Council is hereby authorized to purchase a motor grader, in used condition, meeting the following specifications: 115 Horse Power, with Cab and Heater, a Defroster, Windshield Wipers, Lights, Power Steering and 1300/24 tires, Front and Rear, for a sum not in excess of \$6,000.00 plus a trade in of the old motor grader belonging to the City of Gothenburg, all without the necessity of advertising for bids therefor.

Section 3.

That an emergency exists, and that the provisions regarding an estimate for the purchase price of said motor grader and the advertising for bids for the same as provided in Section 17-708, R.R.S., Neb. 1967, Supplement, are hereby waived.

Section 4.

The prompt passage of this Ordinance is urgent and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, and the posting of a proclamation of the president of the council, as within the time and in the manner as provided by law.
