

THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE OF 1961, GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA

An Ordinance of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, relating to the operation of Pool Halls, within the city limits of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska; to provide for the regulation thereof; to provide that the application for a permit to operate a pool hall be submitted to the Mayor and Council of said city; to provide penalties for the violation thereof, and repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

- 5-16-1 License Required. It shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, firm or corporation to engage in the business of operating a pool hall or pool room within the corporate limits of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, without first obtaining a license therefor from the Mayor and Council of said City.
- 5-16-2 Application for License. Before such license be granted, any applicant shall apply to the Mayor and Council, describing the location of the proposed pool hall or pool room, and the number and description of the tables to be located therein.
- 5-16-3 License Fee. When granted, the annual license fee for the operation of such pool hall or pool room shall be the sum of \$10 for each snooker and each billiard table and \$7.50 for each pool table. All such license fees shall be paid on the first day of May of each year, and no person, partnership, firm or corporation shall operate any such pool hall or pool room without first paying the fee herein provided for, and any person, partnership, firm or corporation who shall for a period of thirty (30) days after said license becomes due refuse or neglect to pay the same shall have their license revoked and shall thereafter not be permitted to operate said pool hall or pool room until a new license be issued as herein provided, and any pool hall or pool room so operating in violation of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a nuisance and may be abated as such. Provided further that said license fee shall be collected in the manner provided in sections of Municipal Code of said City of Gothenburg, and provided further, any person, partnership, firm or corporation who is issued a license to operate a pool hall or pool room after May first, shall pay all license fee for only the remainder of the fiscal year on a pro rata basis.
- 5-16-4 Denial of Application. The City of Gothenburg further reserves the right to deny any application for a license as hereinbefore mentioned, when in the judgement of the Mayor and Council it would be in the best interests of the City of Gothenburg to do so.

5-16-5 Hours of Operation. ___ No pool hall or pool room shall operate and be open for business on Sundays prior to 1:00'clock P. M., and after 12:00 midnight on secular days.

5-16-6 Minors Prohibited. ___ No licensee under this ordinance shall allow minors under the age of sixteen (16) to enter his pool hall or pool room unless said minor is accompanied by one or both of his or her parents, provided a minor over the age of fourteen (14) may have access to said pool hall or pool room upon the presentation of written consent to the management of said pool hall or pool room from his or her parents.

5-16-7 Violation, Penalty. ___ Any person, partnership, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not less than \$5 nor more than \$100 for each offense. Each distinct act or violation of the terms of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.


5-16-8 Repeal of Prior Ordinances in Conflict. ___ All ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

5-16-9 When Operative. ___ This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

grading, curbing, re-curbing, guttering, re-guttering, paving, widening, re-surfacing and otherwise improving such street in said Paving and ~~Improvement~~ District Number 49, except intersections, shall be assessed against each lot or parcel of property within said respective district in proportion to the benefits accruing to said property. That such assessments shall be apportioned as to the benefits by the Mayor and Council sitting as a Board of Adjustment and Equalization, and that each such property shall be especially benefited by said improvement.


SECTION SIX. That the cost of grading, re-grading, curbing, re-curbing, guttering, re-guttering, paving, widening, re-surfacing and otherwise improving such street in said district at the street and alley intersections shall be paid by the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, either by the issuance of warrants or intersection paving bonds.

SECTION SEVEN. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law. That if the majority of the resident owners of the property directly abutting on said street to be improved within said Paving and ~~Improvement~~ District Number 49, created by this ordinance shall file with the City Clerk within twenty days after the first publication of the notice of creation of said district, written objections to the creation of said district, said ordinance shall be repealed.
