ARTICLE I CEMETERY BOARD

An Ordinance of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, providing for the creation of a Cemetery Board; providing for the duties and powers thereof; providing for the terms of office thereof; providing for the repeal of all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict therewith; and prescribing when this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA.

19-1-1 Cemetery Board Created.

There is hereby created a Cemetery Board, which shall consist of six members to be chosen from among the citizens at large of such said City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, who shall serve without pay, and shall have the entire control and management of the Cemetery belonging to the City of Gothenburg.

19-1-2 Terms of Office.

The terms of office of the members of the Cemetery Board initially appointed shall expire two on May 1, 1971, two on May 1, 1972, and two on May 1, 1973 as designated by the Mayor in making the appointments. As the terms of the members expire, the Mayor shall, on or before May 1st each year appoint or reappoint a member of the Cemetery Board for a term of three years to succeed the member whose term expires. Each member shall serve until the election and qualifications of his successors. In case of a vacancy, prior to the expiration of the term of a member, the appointment of a member to fill the vacancy shall be made by the Mayor to be approved by the City Council for the remainder of the unexpired term.

19-1-3 Repeal of Prior Ordinances in Conflict.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances passed and approved

prior to the passage and approval of this Ordinance and in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

19-1-4 When Operative.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
