

An Ordinance providing for the establishment of fees for the operation of utilities owned and operated by the City of Gothenburg, providing for the repeal of prior Ordinances in conflict; and prescribing a time when this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR, AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Definition. Utilities shall include the water works, sewer system and the electrical distribution system owned and operated by the City of Gothenburg.

Section 2. Applications required. Every person desiring a supply of water, connection with the sewage system, or a supply of electricity shall make application therefor to the City Clerk of the City upon blanks to be furnished for that purpose. The application must state truly and fully all the use for which water, electricity, or sewage service is to be applied, as the case may be, and no different or additional use will be allowed except by permission of city council. Not more than one distinct premises, tenement or house shall be supplied from one water tap, from one sewage tap, or from one electrical meter except by special permission.

Section 3. Rates. Rates or charges for service for the electrical distribution system, sewage system, or the water works shall be fixed or changed by Respcolution duly adopted by the City of Gothenburg, in Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 4. Repealing of prior Ordinance in conflict. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this Ordinance and in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. References to other Ordinances. All ordinances referring to the Board of Public Works, either by name or by implication which are still in full force and effect, shall hereafter be construed to refer to the Mayor and City Council.

Section 6. When operative. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
