

ORDINANCE NO. 250

An Ordinance providing for the sale of all of Block Forty-One (41), Summit Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska; providing for the conveyance of said real estate and the matter and terms thereof; providing for notice of said sale; providing when said ordinance shall take effect; and providing for the repeal of all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1.

That the real estate described as follows, to-wit:

All of Block Forty-one (41), Summit
Addition to the City of Gothenburg,
Dawson County, Nebraska,

was not and is not abandoned property and is not used and never was used in the operation of public utilities.

Section 2.

That said real estate shall be sold and conveyed to Paulsen Building and Supply Company Inc., of Dawson County, Nebraska, in exchange for the sum of \$20,000.00.

Section 3.

That notice of said sale shall be published in the manner and with the time as provided by law, which notice shall provide that should a remonstrance against such sale, signed by legal electors of said City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, equal in number to thirty (30) percent of the electors of said City, voting at the last regular municipal election held therein, be filed within thirty days after the passage and publication of this ordinance, said property shall not then nor within one year thereafter be sold, unless such sale be ratified by a majority of the electors of such municipality voting upon the same at a special or general municipal election of which the same is submitted.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its approval, and publication as required by law.

Section 5.


That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
