

ORDINANCE NO. 270

An ordinance to vacate that portion of the alley in Block Twenty-Two (22) in Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, running North (N) and South (S), and more particularly described as commencing at a point One Hundred Fifty Feet East (150' E) of the Northwest (NW) Corner of said Block, thence South Three Hundred Two Feet (S 302'), thence East Twenty Feet (E 20'), thence North Three Hundred Two Feet (N 302'), thence West Twenty Feet (W 20') to the place of beginning; providing that said land shall revert to the adjacent owners as provided by law; providing for repeal of any ordinance in conflict herewith; and providing when said ordinance shall take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

1. WHEREAS, that portion of the alley in Block Twenty-Two (22), Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, running North (N) and South (S), and more particularly described as commencing at a point One Hundred Fifty Feet East (150' E) of the Northwest (NW) Corner of said Block, thence South Three Hundred Two Feet (S 302'), thence East Twenty Feet (E 20'), thence North Three Hundred Two Feet (N 302'), thence West Twenty Feet (W 20') to the place of beginning, is no longer necessary for the use of the citizens of Gothenburg, and it would be to the best interest of said city if the said alley were vacated.


2. That portion of the alley in Block Twenty-Two (22), Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, running North and South (S), and more particularly described as commencing at a point One Hundred Fifty Feet East (150' E) of the Northwest (NW) Corner of said Block, thence South Three Hundred Two Feet (S 302'), thence East Twenty Feet (E 20'), thence North Three Hundred Two Feet (N 302'), thence West Twenty Feet (W 20') to the place of beginning, is hereby vacated.

3. That the land so vacated in section 2 above shall revert to the owners of lands or lots abutting thereto.

4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
