

ORDINANCE NO. 289

An ordinance to amend Article 5-218 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code of 1974, as amended, providing for the placement of signs and other traffic signals; providing for an effective date, and repealing any and all ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section One. Article 5-218 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code of 1974, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit: Signs, Signals. The Governing Body may by a motion, provide for the placing of stop signs, or other signs, signals, standards, or other more mechanical devices in any street or alley under the Municipality's jurisdiction for the purpose of regulating or prohibiting traffic thereon. It shall be unlawful for any person to fail, neglect, or refuse to comply with the regulations or prohibitions set forth in said motion or motions.

Section Two. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication as provided by law.
