

ORDINANCE NO. 305

An Ordinance to amend the appointing authority of the governing body, to provide for the appointment of a police reserve force instead of special policemen.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION ONE: That Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 1-201, of the Municipal Code of Gothenburg, Nebraska, be amended to read as follows:

Appointed Officials; General Authority.

The Mayor, by and with the consent of the City Council, may appoint such officers as shall be required by ordinance or otherwise required by law. Such officers may be removed from office by the Mayor. The Mayor, by and with the consent of the City Council, shall appoint such other officials as may be necessary, and may establish a police reserve force as provided by law. All police officers shall be subject to removal at any time by the Mayor. All other appointed officials shall be subject to removal at any time by the Mayor.

SECTION TWO. That the original Section 1-201 and any Ordinance passed and approved prior to the passage, approval and publication or posting of this Ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
