

ORDINANCE NO. 312

An ordinance to amend the requirements for election officials.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA.

SECTION I. That Chapter I, Article 1, Section 1-709, of the Municipal Code of Gothenburg, Nebraska be amended to read as follows:

Elections; Officials. In the event of a joint Municipal/County Election, the County Clerk shall at least fifteen (15) days prior to the State Primary Elections, give notice of the appointment by each political party of three (3) judges and two (2) clerks of election in each election unit in the Municipality, to be known as the Receiving Board. Each of the appointees referred to shall be of good character, approved integrity, well informed, able to read, write, and speak the English language, reside in the election precinct in which he is to serve, be entitled to vote in his election unit, and hold office for a term of two (2) years, or until judges and clerks of election are appointed for the next State Primary Election. SECTION II. That the original Section 1-709 and any ordinance passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
