

ORDINANCE NO. 357

An Ordinance to establish rules and regulations for conduct in a park or cemetery; providing for repeal of all ordinances in conflict herewith, and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION I. Destruction of property. No person in a park or cemetery shall:

1) Willfully mark, deface, disfigure, injure, tamper with or displace or remove any building, tables, benches, fireplaces, railings, cemetery monuments, stones or markers, other public utilities or parts of appurtenances thereof, signs, notices, placards, monuments, whether temporary or permanent, or other structures or equipment facilities of park and cemetery property or appurtenances whatsoever, either real or personal, or

2) Construct or erect any building or structure of whatever kind, whether permanent or temporary in character, or operate any business in or upon, provide any public service utility into, upon or across such lands, except on written permit issued by the City Administrator.

3) Damage, carve, transplant or remove any tree or plant or injure the bark or pick the flowers or seeds of any tree or plant.

SECTION II. Trash to be deposited in receptacles. No person shall dump, deposit or leave any bottles, broken glass, ashes, paper, boxes, cans, dirt, rubbish, waste, garbage or refuse or other trash in any park or cemetery except in receptacles provided therefore.

SECTION III. Vehicle regulations. All vehicles of every kind are prohibited from driving on any other area except designated roads. Such vehicles shall only be parked in designated parking areas or parallel parking on roads, leaving space for moving vehicles to use road, unless otherwise prohibited by signs erected.
