

ORDINANCE NO. 426

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10-427 OF THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE, ORDINANCE NUMBER 272 RE: THE SPEED AT WHICH TRAINS CAN OPERATE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITHE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Section 10-427 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, Ordinance No. 272 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That Section 10-427 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, Ordinance No. 272 is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, railroad company, or corporations, its agents, servants or employees, owning, running or operating any railroad through or within the corporate limits of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, to drive, run or propel, or cause to be driven, run or propelled upon any railroad track within the corporate limits of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, any engine, locomotive, truck or cars attached to any passenger train, or freight train, at a greater rate of speed than 60 miles per hour.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall be posted in three public places within the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, and published according to law.

Section 5. The reading of this ordinance at three different meetings of the City Council is hereby waived in as much as an emergency exists due to the current speed ordinance causing a dangerous congestion of train traffic within the city limits of Gothenburg that will be alleviated by the passage of this ordinance, and three-fourths or more of the City Council has voted for its passage.




