

ORDINANCE NO. 550

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 8, SECTION 9-801 OF ORDINANCE NO. 272 OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, ADOPTING A PLUMBING CODE BY REFERENCE; DESIGNATING THE SECTION NUMBER THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 9, Article 8, Section 9-801 of Ordinance No. 272 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Section 9-801 of Chapter 9, Article 8 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Municipal Water Department: Adoption of Plumbing Code. To provide certain minimum standards, provisions and requirements for safe and stable installation, methods of connection, and uses of materials in the installation of plumbing and heating, the latest addition of the Plumbing Code, published by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, and printed in book or pamphlet form is hereby incorporated by reference in addition to all later additions and revisions thereof, as though printed in full herein, in so far as said code does not conflict with the statutes of the State of Nebraska. One copy of the plumbing code shall be on file at the office of the municipal clerk and shall be

available for public inspection during normal office hours. The provisions of the plumbing code shall be controlling throughout the municipality and throughout its zoning jurisdiction. (Reference 17-1001, 18-132, R.S. Neb.).

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

Article 8. Plumbing Code

9-801 Plumbing Code; Adopted by Reference. To provide certain minimum standards, provisions, and requirements for safe and stable installation, methods of connection, and uses of materials in the installation of plumbing and heating, the National Plumbing Code, 1973 Edition, published by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, and printed in book or pamphlet form, is hereby incorporated by reference in addition of all amended editions as though printed in full herein insofar as said code does not conflict with the Statutes of the State of Nebraska. Three (3) copies of the Plumbing Code are on file at the office of the Municipal Clerk and are available for public inspection at any reasonable time. The provisions of the Plumbing Code shall be controlling throughout the Municipality and throughout its zoning jurisdiction. (*Ref. 17-1001, 18-132 RS Neb.*)
