

ORDINANCE NO. 553

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AUTHORITY OF THE GOTHENBURG CITY COUNCIL TO SET, BY RESOLUTION THE COSTS AND FEES CHARGED BY THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, RECREATION FACILITY USE FEES, LIBRARY FEES, EQUIPMENT USE, WATER AND SEWER TAP FEES, RETURNED CHECK FEES, INSPECTION FEES, BUILDING AND PERMIT FEES, AND CEMETERY FEES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL SECTIONS OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Gothenburg hereby determines that it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the council to determine, and establish by resolution all user fees, costs and charges made by the City for the various permits, uses, applications and services provided by the City.

Section 2. The City of Gothenburg, by and through its City Council, is authorized to establish by resolution of the council all fees charged by the City of Gothenburg, not withstanding any fees currently established by ordinance. Specifically, the Council may establish by resolution fees for camping; swimming pool use, pavilion rental, ambulance use, library charges, animal pick up, equipment rental, temporary electrical service, including transformer; lot sales and grave opening at the cemetery; electrical inspections, copies, weed cutting, water and sewer taps, returned checks, cement cut, zoning charges,

including variance and special use requests, sprinkler system permits, police department charges, plumbing and electrical inspection charges; mobile home court licenses, pawn shop licenses, building permits, bicycle and animal licenses and electrical licenses and any other fees or charges made by the City.

Section 3. Establishment of fees pursuant to the resolution authorized hereby shall be effective from and after the date of the passage of said resolution.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
