

ORDINANCE NO. 562

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 292, IN SECTION 2-205 OF CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2 OF SAID ORDINANCE AS AMENDED; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Chapter 2, Article 2 Section 2-205 of Ordinance no. 292 is attached hereto.

Section 2. Chapter 2, Article 2 section 2-205 of Ordinance No. 292 of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska is hereby amended as follows:

2-205 ~~PARK-AND~~ RECREATION COMMITTEE.

The governing Body shall appoint the Park and Recreation Committee. The Committee shall consist of 14 members, who shall be resident freeholders in the Municipality. The members of the Committee shall serve a one (1) year term of office unless reappointed. The Committee shall serve without compensation and may be required, in the discretion of the Governing Body to give a bond in a sum set by resolution of the Governing Body, and conditioned upon the faithful performance of their duties. At the time of the Committee's first meeting in June of each year, the Committee shall organize by selecting from their number a chairman and secretary. It shall be the duty of the secretary to keep the full and correct minutes and records of all meetings, and to file the same with the Municipal Clerk where they shall be available for public inspection at any reasonable time. A majority of the Committee members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The committee shall meet at such times as the Governing body may designate. Special meetings may be held upon the call of the chairman, or any two (2) of the Committee members. It shall be the duty of the Committee to take the immediate charge of all parks and recreational

facilities belonging to the Municipality. The Committee shall establish appropriate rules and regulations for the management, use and operation of the same. All actions of the Committee shall be subject to the review and control of the Governing Body. The Committee shall be responsible for making such reports and performing such other duties as the Governing Body may, from time to time, designate. No member of the Park and Recreation Committee shall serve in the capacity of both the chairman and secretary of the Committee.

Section 3. That any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and hereby are repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
