

ORDINANCE NO. 567

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF SECOND STREET
IN THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA;
DESCRIBING THE LIMITS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR A REVERSION OF
OWNERSHIP TO THE ABUTTING LANDOWNERS; REPEALING ALL
ORDINANCES AND CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All that portion of Second Street, in
the City of Gothenburg located within the boundaries of the
Gothenburg Improvement Company Addition to the City of
Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska is hereby vacated.


Section 2. The ownership of the above described
real estate shall revert one half to the abutting owners on
each side thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances
in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective
