

ORDINANCE NO. 571

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V, SECTION 304 OF THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR LOWERED SPEED LIMITS ON AVENUE I WHEN YELLOW LIGHTS ARE FLASHING; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska as follows:

Section 1. A copy of Article V, Section 304 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Article V, Section 304 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following language thereto:

Between the north line of 16th Street and the south line of 13th Street on Avenue I, during such times as yellow flashing lights are lit, 15 miles per hour (the governing body may by resolution authorize lighting the flashing yellow lights during the time school is in session, there is activity on municipal ball parks or the municipal swimming pool is open).

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and hereby are repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

§5-304 SPEED LIMITS. No person shall operate a motor vehicle on any street, alley, or other place at a rate of speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions, but in no event shall the speed of a vehicle exceed the following:

U.S. Highway #30 from the west corporate limits to the west end of the bridge over the tail race.40 miles per hour

U.S. Highway #30 from the west end of the bridge over the tail race to a point 200 feet east of the east line of Avenue I35 miles per hour

U.S. Highway #30 from a point 200 feet east of the east line of Avenue I to the east corporate limits. 45 miles per hour

State Highway #47 from a point on the south corporate limits to a point 250 feet south of the south line of 4th Street.50 miles per hour

State Highway #47 (Lake Avenue) from a point 250 feet south of the south line of 4th Street to the south line of U.S. Highway #30.35 miles per hour

State Highway #47 (Lake Avenue) from the south line of U.S. Highway #30 to the north line of 13th Street25 miles per hour

State Highway #47 (Lake Avenue) from the north line of 13th Street to the north line of 20th Street. . . .30 miles per hour

From the north line of 20th Street to the north corporate limits. . . .35 miles per hour

School zones as designated by the Governing Body.15 miles per hour

16th Street from the west line of Avenue A to the west terminus of 16th Street.15 miles per hour

All roads within the boundaries of the Municipal parks. 10 miles per hour

All other streets and highways within the corporate limits. 25 miles per hour

Where a different maximum speed is set by ordinance, appropriate signs shall be posted. (Ref. 39-662, 39-663 RS Neb.)(Amended by Ord. Nos. 364, 7/17/79; 404, 11/4/80)
