

ORDINANCE NO. 1017

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATING A PORTION A UTILITY EASEMENT IN LOT 4 OF COUNTRY ACRES THIRD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska hereby declares it to be in the public interest to vacate that portion of the Utility Easement hereafter described.

Section 2. That certain Utility Easement on the south of Lot 4 of Country Acres Third Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska being 5 foot in width, and running from the east line of said Lot to a point 5 feet east of the west line of Lot 4 is hereby vacated.

Section 3. Specifically excluded from this vacation is that portion of the Utility Easement 5 feet in width and parallel and adjacent to the westerly boundary of said Lot 4. The City of Gothenburg specifically reserves said 5 foot Easement along the westerly boundary of said Lot 4.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to file a copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the Register of Deeds in Dawson County, Nebraska.






