

ORDINANCE 635

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 117 OF THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE, ORDINANCE 272, PROVIDING FOR HOURS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO INCLUDE OFF SALE AND BOTTLE CLUB SALES ON DECEMBER 31; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Section 117, Article 1, Chapter 10 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, as amended by ordinance 572, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Section 117, Article 1, Chapter 10 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, as amended by ordinance 572, is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or their agents to sell any alcoholic liquors within the municipality except as provided herein, and except as may be otherwise provided by the laws of the State of Nebraska, to-wit:

LIQUOR AND BEER OFF SALE

Sunday	12:00 noon to 6:00 P.M.
Monday through Friday	6:00 A.M. to 11:45 P.M.
Saturday	6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M. Sunday

BEER ON SALE

Monday through Friday	6:00 A.M. to 11:45 P.M.
Saturday	6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M. Sunday

BOTTLE CLUB

Monday through Thursday	6:00 A.M. to 11:45 P.M.
Friday	6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M. Saturday
Saturday	6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M. Sunday

Provided, however, on the 31st day of December in each year, it shall be lawful to dispense alcoholic liquors, including beer, under a bottle club license between the hours of 6 p m and 1 a m, on the following January 1, notwithstanding the above limitations.


No person shall consume any alcoholic beverage on a licensed premise for a period of time longer than 15 minutes after the time fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on said premises.

Section 3. All ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.



ORDINANCE NO. 572

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 10, SECTION 117 OF THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE, ORDINANCE NO. 272, PROVIDING FOR THE HOURS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO INCLUDE OFF SALE ON SUNDAYS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Article 10, Section 117 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, Ordinance No. 272 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Article 10, Section 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or their agents to sell any alcoholic liquors within the municipality except as provided herein, and except as may be otherwise provided by the laws of the State of Nebraska, to-wit:

LIQUOR AND BEER OFF SALE

Sunday	12 noon to 6:00 p.m.
Monday through Friday	6:00 a.m. to 11:45 p.m.
Saturday	6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m., Sunday

BEER ON SALE

Monday through Friday	6:00 a.m. to 11:45 p.m.
Saturday	6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m., Sunday

BOTTLE CLUB

Monday through

Thursday 6:00 a.m. to 11:45 p.m.

Friday 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.,

Saturday

Saturday 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m., Sunday

Provided, however, on the 31st day of December in each year, it shall be lawful to dispense alcoholic liquors, including beer, under a bottle club license between the hours of 6:00 a.m. until 12:45 p.m., notwithstanding the above limitations, except on those occasions when the 31st day of December falls on Sunday.

No person or persons shall consume any alcoholic beverages on licensed premises for a period of time longer than 15 minutes after the time fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on said premises.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

§10-117 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; HOURS OF SALE. It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or their agents to sell any alcoholic liquors within the Municipality on Sundays, except as provided herein. It shall be lawful to sell beer on and off sale between the hours of six (6:00) o'clock A.M., and eleven forty-five (11:45) o'clock P.M. on the secular days; Provided, on Saturdays such sales shall be allowed until one (1:00) o'clock A.M. Sunday. It shall be lawful to sell liquor off sale between the hours of six (6:00) o'clock A.M., and eleven forty-five (11:45) o'clock P.M. on the secular days; Provided, on Saturdays such sales shall be allowed until one (1:00) o'clock A.M. Sundays. It shall be lawful to sell or dispense alcoholic liquors under a bottle club license between the hours of six (6:00) o'clock A.M. and eleven forty-five (11:45) o'clock P.M. on the secular days; Provided, on Fridays such sales shall be allowed until one (1:00) o'clock A.M. Saturday and on Saturdays such sales shall be allowed until one (1:00) o'clock A.M. Sunday.

Provided, however, on the thirty-first (31st) day of December in each year it shall be lawful to dispense alcoholic liquors, including beer, under a bottle club license between the hours of six (6:00) o'clock A.M. until twelve forty-five (12:45) o'clock P.M., notwithstanding the limitations above provided, except on those occasions

when the thirty-first (31st) day of December falls on Sunday.

No person or persons shall consume any alcoholic beverages on licensed premises for a period of time longer than fifteen (15) minutes after the time fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on the said premises.
