by a majority of all members of the Council, the Mayor declared the ordinance adopted and the Mayor in the presence of the Council signed and approved the ordinance and the Clerk attested the passage and approval of the same and affixed her signature thereto and ordered the Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form as provided therein. A true, correct and complete copy of said ordinance is as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 704

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA, CREATING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 112; DEFINING THE SAME AND THE LIMITS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR PAVING, GRADING, CURBING AND GUTTERING OF SUCH OTHER WORK AS IS NECESSARY AND INCIDENTAL THERETO; PROVIDING FOR PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, ESTIMATES OF COST AND SECURING OF BIDS; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH WORK AND OTHER EXPENSES INCIDENTAL THERETO; PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT OF THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT WARRANTS OR BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES AND DISTRICT BONDS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALING OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND ORDERING THE PUBLICATION OF THE ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Street Improvement District No. 112 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska is hereby created.

Section 2. Said Street Improvement District No. 112 shall include and encompass the designated portions of the following streets in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, and the limits, boundaries and improvements are defined and established as follows:

STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 112

THE STREET TO BE IMPROVED BY PAVING, GRADING, CURBING AND GUTTERING AND INCIDENTAL WORK CONNECTED THEREWITH IS:

9th St, from easterly line Ave D, easterly to approximately 100 feet westerly of the original westerly line of Ave G. ~~10th St, from easterly line Ave D easterly to easterly line of Ave F. Lake Ave from northerly line 8th St, northerly to point 160 feet northerly from northerly line 10th St. Ave F from northerly line 8th St, northerly to northerly line 10th St.~~

THE ABUTTING PROPERTY TO BE INCLUDED IN THE DISTRICT IS LOCATED WITHIN THE FOLLOWING BOUNDARIES:

~~Lots 4 thru 11, inclusive of Block 3, All block 4, All block 5 and Lots 2 thru 6, inclusive of Block 6, all within Original Town of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska; together with Lots 1,2,3, 10,11,12, Block 9, all Block 16, Lots 7 thru 12, inclusive of Block 17, Lots 7 thru 12, inclusive of Block 24, all~~

within the First Addition to the Original Town of Gothenburg, Dawson
County, Nebraska

Section 3. The City's special engineer has made detailed plans and specifications for said improvements and an estimate of the cost thereof, which have been approved by the City Council. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City for such work upon compliance with and in accordance with advertising, bidding and contracting procedures prescribed in Nebraska revised Statutes Section 17-568.01. The City Council shall have and hereby reserves the right to reject any and all bids received.

Section 4. The work and improvements shall be made at public cost, but special assessments on any properties determined by the City Council to be especially benefitted thereby, proportionate to benefits, shall be levied to reimburse the City to the extent provided by law.

Section 5. The District created hereby is separate and distinct, and if the District is objected to by owners of record title representing more than 50% of the front footage of the property directly abutting on the street, street, ally or alleys to be improved, the work will not be constructed in the District.

Section 6. For the purpose of paying for the paving, grading, widening, curbing and guttering or other necessary improvements incidental thereto, the Mayor and City Council of the City may issue district improvement warrants or bond anticipation notes of Street Improvement District No. 112 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska in the form and manner provided by law.

Section 7. To effect the final payment and retirement of said warrants or notes, and to pay for the cost of paving, grading, widening, curbing and guttering or other necessary improvements incidental thereto, the Mayor and City Council shall issue bonds in the form and manner provided by law.


Section 8. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Gothenburg Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section 9. After the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance as in Section 8 provided, there shall be published, as provided by law, in The Gothenburg Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, a notice with respect to the Districts created by the terms of this ordinance, which notice shall provide, among other things, that if owners of record title representing more than 50% of the front footage of the property directly abutting on the street, streets, alley and alleys to be improved in


said District shall file with the City Clerk within twenty (20) days after the first publication of said notice, written objections to the creation of said District, the improvements in such District shall not be made as provided in this ordinance.

Section 10. All provisions of any prior ordinances of the City of conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
