
A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, was held at the City Courcit Chambers in said City on the 3nd day of Febr., 2004, at \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_; Council Members: Joyce Hudson, Roger Dudlay Absent: Notice of the None meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Gothenburg Times, a designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Affidavit of Publication attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to the Mayor and all members of the Council. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Council Member Duckley introduced Ordinance No. 786 entitled: ORDINANCE NO. 786 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG. NEBRASKA, CREATING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2005; 113 DEFINING THE SAME AND THE LIMITS THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR PAVING, GRADING, CURBING AND GUTTERING OF STREETS AND SUCH OTHER WORK AS IS NECESSARY AND INCIDENTAL THERETO; PROVIDING FOR PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, ESTIMATES OF COST AND SECURING OF BIDS; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH WORK AND OTHER EXPENSES INCIDENTAL THERETO; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT WARRANTS OR BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES AND DISTRICT BONDS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALING OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND ORDERING THE PUBLICATION OF THE ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM. and moved that the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. Council Member Novecen seconded the motion to suspend the rules and upon roll call, vote on the motion the following Council Members voted YEA: Judson adopted by three-fourths of the Council and the statutory rule was declared suspended for consideration of said ordinance.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

FORM.

Section 1. Street Improvement District No. 2004-1 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska is hereby created.

Section 2. Said Street Improvement District No. 2004-1 shall include and encompass the designated portions of the following streets in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, and the limits, boundaries and improvements are defined and established as follows:

STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2004-1 113

THE STREET TO BE IMPROVED BY PAVING, GRADING, CURBING AND GUTTERING OF STREETS AND INCIDENTAL WORK

## CONNECTED THEREWITH IS:

25th Street and 26th Street, from Avenue J to the West line of City Replat of Blocks 3 through 7, Hilltop Estates Subdivision in Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska

THE ABUTTING PROPERTY TO BE INCLUDED IN THE DISTRICT IS LOCATED WITHIN THE FOLLOWING BOUNDARIES:

Lots 1 through 6, Block 1, Lots 1 through 14, Block 2, and Lots 1 through 6, Block 3, all in City Replat of Blocks 3 through 7, Hilltop Estates Subdivision, and Part of Block 7, Hilltop Estates Subdivision described as <u>Exhibit</u> A all in the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. The City's special engineer has made detailed plans and specifications for said improvements and an estimate of the cost thereof, which have been approved by the City Council. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City for such work upon compliance with and in accordance with advertising, bidding and contracting procedures prescribed in Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 17-568.01. The City Council shall have and hereby reserves the right to reject any and all bids received.

Section 4. The work and improvements shall be made at public cost, but special assessments on any properties determined by the City Council to be especially benefitted thereby, proportionate to benefits, shall be levied to reimburse the City to extent provided by law.

Section 5. The District created hereby is separate and distinct, and if the District is objected to by owners of record title representing more than 50% of the front footage of the property directly abutting on the street, streets, alley or alleys to be improved, the work will not be constructed in the District.

Section 6. For the purpose of paying for the paving, grading, widening, curbing and guttering streets, and other necessary improvements incidental thereto, the Mayor and City Council of the City may issue district improvement warrants or bond anticipation notes of Street Improvement District No. 2004-1 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska in the form and manner provided by law.

Section 7. To effect the final payment and retirement of said warrants or notes, and to pay for the cost of paving, grading, widening, curbing and guttering or other necessary improvements incidental thereto, the Mayor and City Council shall issue bonds in the form and manner provided by law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be published one time in The Gothenburg Times, a

legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section 9. After the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance as in Section 8 provided, there shall be published, as provided by law, in The Gothenburg Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, a notice with respect to the Districts created by the terms of this ordinance, which notice shall provide, among other things, that if owners of record title representing more than 50% of the front footage of the property directly abutting on the street, streets, alley and alleys to be improved in said District shall file with the City Clerk within twenty (20) days after the first publication of said notice, written objections to the creation of said District, the improvements in such District shall not be made as provided in this ordinance.

Section 10. All provisions of any prior ordinance of the City of conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Part of Block 7 of Hilltop Estates Subdivision of part of the NE1/4 of Section 10, Township 11 North, Range 25 West of the 6th P.M., and within the city of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Block 7 of Hilltop Estates Subdivision of part of the NE1/4 of Section 10, Township 11 North, Range 25 West of the 6th P.M., and within the city of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska:.

Thence S 0°30'20" E (an assumed bearing), along the West Line of Avenue L, and parallel to the East Line of the NE1/4 of said Section 10, a distance of 174.20 feet; Thence S 89°29'40" W, and parallel to the South Line of said Block 7, a distance of 95.60 feet;

Thence N 0°30'20" W, and parallel to the East Line of the NE1/4 of said Section 10, a distance of 173.39 feet, to a point on the North Line of said Block 7; Thence N 89°00'23" E, along the North Line of said Block 7, and parallel to the North Line of the NE1/4 of said Section 10, a distance of 95.60 feet, to the Point of Beginning.
