## ORDINANCE NO. SO

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, AMENDING ARTICLE 10, SECTION 10-120 RELATING TO CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. A copy of Section 10-120 of the Ordinances of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County is attached hereto.

Section 2. Section 10-120 of the Ordinances of the City of Gothenburg is hereby amended to read as follows:

## §10-120 **PLACES**.

## **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: CONSUMPPTION IN PUBLIC**

It shall be unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic beverages within the corporate limits upon public ways and property, including inside vehicles while upon public ways and property, unless the City Council has, by resolution, authorized such consumption in a particular location. Provided, however, in all events, the City Council, may not provide for the consumption of alcoholic beverages on city property for private parties. It is the intent of this section that authorization be for the limited benefit of community gatherings, authorized city employee functions and authorized Volunteer Fire Department meetings and approved functions. It shall further be unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic beverages within any other public business that is not a licensed liquor establishment.

<u>Section 3</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance shall become effective from and after it passage, approval and publication as required by law.
