AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF 21ST STREET; DESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF TITLE TO REGISTERED OWNERS OF VACATED STREET, RETAINING EASEMENTS LOCATED IN THE VACATED PORTION OF SAID STREETS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of the street described in this section is hereby declared vacated, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this ordinance, to-wit:

The property described on attached Exhibit "A".

Section 2. The ownership of the street so vacated shall revert to the joining land owners, subject to a reservation in the City of Gothenburg of all rights-of-way for utilities currently in place, including the right to enter upon, repair, replace and maintain such utilities, including underground pipes, wires and poles.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
