

R E S O L U T I O N

Whereas the following described real estate owned and dedicated by said City as a public park and whereas in our judgments such real estate is no longer necessary or desirable for use as a public park, now, therefore, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, that said real estate which lies within the boundaries of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, described as:

The South one hundred sixty-six feet (S166') of the West one hundred thirty feet (W130') and the South eighty one feet (S81') of the East two hundred forty five feet (E245') of Block Forty-two (42), Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska,

shall be conveyed to School District No. 20, Dawson County, Nebraska, for the unrestricted use of said School District.

That the tract described as:

The North one hundred thirty-four feet (N134') of the West One Hundred thirty feet (W130') of Block Forty-two (42), Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska,

shall be conveyed to School District No. 20, Dawson County, Nebraska, subject to the agreement of said district that no building be constructed on said tract at this time or at any time hereafter, and that in consideration of such conveyance, School District No. 20, Dawson County, Nebraska, agrees to landscape and maintain all of the remaining portion of the said Block Forty-two (42), Hyde Park Addition, title to which is retained in the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, except the area enclosed for the swimming pool as the same is now constructed.

The foregoing resolution is offered by Councilman George Mann at the regular meeting of the City Council of Gothenburg, Nebraska, held on the 6th day of April, 1954.

The foregoing resolution having been offered and read, the same was ordered laid over until the regular meeting on May 4, 1954, at which time the same will be submitted to a vote of the council as required by Section 79-4, 145, of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska. Said action being ordered by the Mayor.
