The following resolution was presented by Councilman Mann

who moved its adoption:

NEBRASKA:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG,

1. The Mayor and Council find and determine: That in exchange for \$39,500.00 Refunding Bonds dated December 15, 1953, there has been received \$9,500.00 Water Bonds dated April 1, 1947, numbers 1 to 10 inclusive, Bond No. 1 for \$500.00 and Bonds Nos. 2 to 10 for \$1,000.00 each, and \$30,000.00 Water Bonds dated November 1, 1948, numbers 7 to 36 inclusive for \$1,000.00 each.
2. The Clerk be and is hereby instructed to destroy the above mentioned Water Bonds dated April 1, 1947 and November 1, 1948 in the presence of the Mayor and City Council by burning.

The foregoing resolution was seconded by Councilman Bode and upon roll call the following Councilmen voted in favor of said resolution:
