

It was moved by Council RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the ordinances of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, were last revised on the 7th day of December, 1927 in the Municipal Code of Gothenburg, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council believes it advisable and necessary that said Municipal Code of Gothenburg, Nebraska, be revised as of this date so as to include all the permanent ordinances passed since the last revision and any other additions being necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, that the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, does hereby employ the firm of Perry, Perry & Nuernberger, attorneys at law, as special attorneys of this City to revise the last Municipal Code of the City and all subsequent ordinances passed by the Mayor and Council of said City for the sum of \$1,250.00. The sum of Fifty Dollars having already been paid on said amount, the balance of \$1200.00 shall be payable to said special attorneys as said work progresses, said payments to be determined by the City Attorney of the City, and the final payment shall be made by the City when the final draft of said new Municipal Code is furnished to the City ready for final passage.

It is understood that the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, will furnish three copies of the old municipal code and one copy of all pertinent ordinances passed subsequent to the old municipal code. The special attorneys shall furnish to the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, one copy of the new code ready for the printer in accordance with the letter of said firm to the City Attorney of Gothenburg, Nebraska dated November 1, 1958.
