

RESOLUTION NO. 7-A

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, that the details, specifications, including the general stipulations thereto attached for the construction of paving, curbing and guttering and sewer laterals prepared by Nosky & Hickey, special engineers employed by the city to prepare the same, and filed in the office of the city clerk on the 1st day of September, 1955, be and the same are hereby approved and adopted.

Be it further resolved, that all bids for the construction of said improvement shall be subject to the said specifications and general stipulations and the following instructions to bidders:

1. All bids to be on the Blanks to be furnished by the City Clerk, and the full name or names of the bidders, their post office address, and the name of the post office address of each person associated or interested with them therein shall be stated in each bid.
2. That each bid for the paving must be accompanied by a certified bank check for a sum equal to 5% of the bid payable unconditionally to the treasurer of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, as a guaranty of good faith, to be retained and collected by the city as liquidated damages, in case the bid is accepted and the bidder neglects or refuses to enter into a contract pursuant thereto or to give the bond hereinafter mentioned; upon the execution of such contract by a successful bidder and his giving of said bond and its approval by the Mayor and Council of the City, his said check shall be returned to him. The checks of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned to them respectively immediately upon the rejection of their bids.

3. Successful bidders will be respectively required to enter into a written contract pursuant thereto within 10 days from the date the same was accepted, and to guarantee the work for a period of one years, and within the same time to furnish a good and sufficient bond in the sum of the total contract price, to the city, with one or more corporate sureties, to be approved by the Mayor and Council, conditioned that the principal obligee shall well and truly keep and perform his part of his

said contract and well and truly pay all claims for labor or material used or employed by him in the performance of said contract, and save and hold the city safe and harmless from any and all such claims, and from all claims of employees for injury to persons or property incurred in the performance of said contract or the construction of the work there- by contemplated, and for any and all claims for damages, caused by any negligent act or omission of the said principal obligee, his agents, ser- vants or employees in and about the prosecution of said work, guarding the same or in any manner connected therewith. The contract shall provide that work thereunder shall commence as soon as material is available and shall be completed as soon thereafter as possible.

4. Bids must be made on every item, for the kind of paving bid for, and the list of extras, all of which will appear on the bidding blanks to be furnished by the City Clerk.

5. The city reserves the right to reject any and all bids without explanation and for any reason it may see fit.

6. The published proposal for bids will be a part of any contract made for the construction of said improvements.

Be it further resolved that the city clerk be and she is hereby authorized and empowered and directed, for and on behalf of the city to advertise for bids for the construction of the improvements in paving Districts Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17 and 18 of the City of Gothenburg, in the Gothenburg Times, of Gothenburg, Nebraska, by the publication therein for at least 21 days of the following notice:
