

RESOLUTION NO, 207

RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

WHEREAS, it appears that there is no need of keeping city records, other than permanent ordinances and permanent resolutions and the minutes of the City Clerk, which are over ten years old, and that the space occupied by the said old records are needed in the operation of said city.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the records of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, more than ten years old, other than permanent minutes of the City Clerk, permanent ordinances and permanent resolutions, be destroyed and that the City Clerk is hereby authorized to forthwith destroy all of said old records so ordered to be destroyed.
