

RESOLUTION NUMBER 234

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of November, 1963, Ordinance Number 178, was passed by the Mayor and City Council of Gothenburg, Nebraska, declaring that the real estate described as follows, to-wit:

The South Fifty Feet in width of Lot One (1), and the East Twenty-six Feet in width of the South Fifty Feet in width of Lot Two (2), all in Block One (1), of the Lakeview Addition to the Town, now City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, as surveyed, platted and recorded,

was not and never was used, then nor now in the operation of public utilities, nor was acquired through tax foreclosure proceedings, and that for the purpose of transferring the title, all interests in the City of Gothenburg were to be sold to AGNES R. JACOX, for the sum of \$200.55, in cash.

Section 2.

WHEREAS, the Notice of the proposed sale was duly published in the Gothenburg Times, a legal newspaper located within the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, in the manner and with the time as provided by law.

Section 3.

WHEREAS, no remonstrance has been filed against the said proposed sale with the City Clerk of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska.

Section 4.

WHEREAS, that the \$200.55 as payment in full for the conveyance of the said City of its interests in said real estate has been paid.

Section 5.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Clerk shall execute a warranty deed conveying said interests of the said City of Gothenburg, to

AGNES R. JACOX.
