

RESOLUTION NUMBER 238

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG,

NEBRASKA:

Section 1.

Whereas on the 7th day of April, 1964, Ordinance Number 179 was passed by the Mayor and City Council of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, declaring the real estate described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which lies 2,895 Feet south and 748 Feet west of the northeast corner of Section Fifteen (15), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Twenty-five (25), West of the 6th P.M., in Dawson County, Nebraska, thence going north 701' east for a distance of 250 feet, thence going south 82059' east for a distance of 200 Feet, thence going south 701' west for a distance of 250 Feet, thence going north 82059' west for a distance of 200 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.15 acres,

was not and never was used, then nor now in the operation of public utilities, nor was acquired through tax foreclosure proceedings, and for the purpose of transferring the title, all interest in the City of Gothenburg, were sold to Gothenburg Golf Club, a non-profit corporation, duly organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska, for the sum of \$ 396.55, in cash.

Section 2.

Whereas the notice of the proposed sale was duly published in the Gothenburg Times, a legal newspaper located in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, in the manner and within the time as provided by law.

Section 3.

Whereas, no remonstrance has been filed against the said proposed sale with the City Clerk of Gothenburg, Nebraska.

Section 4.

Whereas, that \$ 396.55 as payment in full for the conveyance of the said city of its interests in said real estate has been paid.

Section 5.

Whereas, the Mayor and City Clerk shall execute a warranty deed conveying said interests of the said City of Gothenburg, to the Gothenburg Golf Club, a non-profit corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska, upon final approval of sale by the Federal Aviation Agency.
