

R E S O L U T I O N 241

A Resolution providing for the destruction of City records which are more than ten years old.

1. That all old records, more than ten years old, now in the possession of the City Clerk of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, be destroyed by the City Clerk, as provided by Section 18-1701 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1957 Supplement.
