CALL FOR A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA

A special meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, is hereby called to be held at City Hall in said City on the 10th day of March, 1967 at 5 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of considering the adequacy of petitions filed with the City Council requesting the calling of a special election on the question of issuing Hospital Bonds of the City of Gothenburg, and for the purpose of considering passage of a Resolution calling a special election to submit to the legal voters of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, the proposition of issuing Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) of Hospital Bonds of the City of Gothenburg for the purpose of purchasing real estate and erecting a building thereon for hospital purposes and to equip such municipal hospital, and for the further purpose of taking such other action as is necessary in connection therewith.

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, met in special session at City Hall on the 10th day of March, 1967, at 5 o'clock P.M., pursuant to notice and call.

Mayor L. R. Brand, presided and the City Clerk Jane Ballmer, recorded the proceedings. The following councilmen were present: Wesley Stebbins, M.J. Ayres, Arlond Garratt, Warren Lamb. The following were absent: None.

Councilman Arlond Garratt introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

R E S O L U T I O N No. 259

"WHEREAS, petitions have been filed with the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, petitioning the Mayor and said City Council to call a special election to submit to the legal voters of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, the proposition of issuing Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) of Hospital Bonds of the City of Gothenburg for the purpose of purchasing real estate and erecting a building thereon for hospital purposes and to equip such municipal hospital; and

WHEREAS, said petitions have been fully and carefully examined and considered by the Mayor and City Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

1. The petitions filed are in proper and legal form and are signed by 156 legal voters of the City of Gothenburg; that at the last General Election prior to the presenting of such petitions the number of legal voters voting for the office of governor was 1006, and that the number of legal voters signing the aforesaid petitions is in excess of 10% of said legal voters who voted for the office of governor at the last General Election.

2. That a special municipal election to be held on Tuesday, April 4, 1967 in the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, is hereby called at which election there shall be submitted to the electors of said City the following proposition:

"Shall the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, issue and sell its negotiable bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$500,000.00 for the purpose of purchasing real estate and erecting a building thereon for hospital purposes and to equip such municipal hospital, said bonds to be dated at the time of their issuance and become due and payable in a period not exceeding twenty (20) years from their date; provided, however, that any or all of said bonds shall be redeemable at the option of said City at any time on or after five (5) years from the date of issuance thereof, and shall bear interest at not to exceed the legal rate per annum; and

Shall the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, cause to be levied annually in addition to all other taxes, a special levy of taxes by valuation on all the taxable property in said City sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as such interest and principal become due and payable?"

3. The City Clerk shall cause ballots to be printed which shall set forth the above proposition at length followed by the words "Yes" and "No" with a square opposite each word. Voters desiring to vote in favor of said proposition will mark an "X" in the square preceding the word "Yes". Voters desiring to vote against said proposition shall mark an "X" in the square preceding the word "No".

4. Polls for voting at said election shall remain open from 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 P.M. on said date and shall be located at the following places in said City of Gothenburg:

East Ward - Community Building
West Ward - City Council Chambers - City Hall

5. Said special election shall be conducted in the manner provided for by law for elections in cities of the second class.
6. Notice of said special election shall be given by publication in Gothenburg Times, a legal newspaper published in and of general circulation in the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, three (3) successive weeks prior to April 4, 1967, which notice shall be in substantially the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the electors of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, that a special election has been called to be held in said City on the 4th day of April, 1967, at which election there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, the following proposition:

"Shall the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, issue and sell its negotiable bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$500,000.00 for the purpose of purchasing real estate and erecting a building thereon for hospital purposes and to equip such municipal hospital, said bonds to be dated at the time of their issuance and become due and payable in a period not exceeding twenty (20) years from their date; provided, however, that any or all of said bonds shall be redeemable at the option of said City at any time on or after five (5) years from the date of issuance thereof, and shall bear interest at not to exceed the legal rate per annum; and

Shall the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, cause to be levied annually in addition to all other taxes, a special levy of taxes by valuation on all the taxable property in said City sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as such interest and principal become due and payable?"

The polls shall be open from 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. on said date.
