

RESOLUTION No. 260

A Resolution providing for the destruction of City records which are more than ten years old.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That all records, more than ten years old, now in the possession of the City Clerk of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska be destroyed by the City Clerk, as provided by Section 18-1701 of the Revises Statutes of Nebraska, 1957 Supplement.
