

WHEREAS, the U. S. Congress, through the enacted Economic Opportunity Act, as amended in 1967, provides for a political subdivision of a State or a combination of such subdivisions, to designate a private nonprofit corporation as the community action agency to provide benefits available under the said Act for its residents;

WHEREAS, the Mid-Nebraska Community Action Program, Inc., is currently approved by the Office of Economic Opportunity, and in the past has been designated and recognized as the community action agency to serve the Counties of Buffalo, Dawson, Kearney, Phelps, Franklin, Harlan, and Gosper -- each aforesaid County Board of Supervisors (or Commissioners) having previously (prior to said 1967 Amendments to the Economic Opportunity Act) set forth their respective designations in Resolutions;

WHEREAS, public notice was posted and copies of the same were mailed to the existing community action agency and all its current delegate agencies, in accord with requirements set out in Section 210 of the 1967 Amendments to the Economic Opportunity Act;

WHEREAS, the specific proposal before said Gothenburg City Council on this 7th day of May, 1968, is to designate Mid-Nebraska Community Action Program, Inc. as the official and legal community action agency to serve the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Gothenburg City Council does hereby, pursuant to Section 210, Public Law 90-222, 90th Congress of the U. S. of America, S. 2388, December 23, 1967 (Green Amendment), designate Mid-Nebraska Community Action Program, Inc. as the official and legal community action agency to serve the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska.
